1. Main objectives of the sub-project

- Developing information and training materials appropriate for each of the participants
- Conducting training courses combined with presentations and demonstrations to enable an integrated approach to solving problems associated with obtaining improvement in energy efficiency
- To familiarize government officials and employees of public institutions with legal regulations in force
- Exchange experiences and good practices and information on the latest organisational solutions and technologies used to improve energy efficiency in the framework of regional trainings, courses
- Study visits to their partners and to develop information publications

2. Main outputs + results

- Review and evaluation of existing training tools in the regions
- Identification of good and best practices in the area of development and improvement of training tools for authorities and public administration employees on issues of energy efficiency
- Building and developing a network of contacts between participants involved in the project at various levels (political, administrative, expert and civil one)
- Developing recommendations and undertaking joint political initiatives concerning establishing universal standards for tools and methods for training workers of public administration
- Establishing or strengthening the existing relations between public authorities, educational institutions and non-governmental organizations (NGO's) in achieving the objectives of the EEMTE project

3. Deviations from the original plan?

- There were no significant deviations from the project plan, except for some financial shift within the budget lines
- Some lectures and training sessions was planned to be held in 1-st and 2-nd reporting periods will be held during the fall of 2012 and winter and spring 2013.
- Due to money problems with certifications of projects in Poland the Implementing Authority for European Programmes from Warsaw have to stop controlling procedure.

4.1. Policies improved in the regions

Lower Silesia



- Local authorities receive a package of information materials on EE adapted to the needs of all interested entities involved in the processes affecting the growth of energy efficiency.
- Staff of public institutions and representatives of local authorities can consciously and effectively plan and implement projects supported with public funds and EU funds, based on the knowledge of all aspects of improving EE.
- Educational institutions and the NGO sector through the creation and development of networks and advisory associations supported in order to improve the EE at local and regional level
- Local businesses and consultants can provide appropriate services based on local materials
- The best benefit for Jelcz-Laskowice and Lower Silesia will be start to work Local Ecology Education Centre. This institution has a chance to play very important role in propagation and dissemination EE ideas and knowledge and who be very good place to organize interregional cooperation in future.

4.2 Policies improved in the regions

Saxony

- The City of Leipzig will benefit of the immediate results and experiences with the users (f.e. staff head, teachers, caretaker, technical staff) of the reviewed school for the following passive house projects in the near future. The focus of the other SPP is more general and will help, also to improve the information of all civil servants of the City of Leipzig for on energy behaviour in buildings of public administration. The focus to disseminate this informations and outputs as a result of EEMTE will be at first the structural engineering office. With this experiences can be finally addressed all civil servants in the City of Leipzig.

4.3 Policies improved in the regions

Haute-Savoie



➤ The municipality has decided to apply Kyoto Protocol by setting up an Agenda 21 (energy audit of public buildings, carbon footprint of the city) with the project, the all staff of the city as well as the private partner working on the organization of a music festival (scene installation enterprise, local suppliers of material and food) which represent a team à 500 people all together will be trained to energy efficient behaviour and methodology. And raising awareness of the public is also planned. Cluses General Director of technical services being the president of the association of GDS of France, communication will be made to all the members all over France on this methodology. Moreover, Cluses will organize in partnership with Conseil General of Haute-Savoie a round table with all the organizers of Haute-Savoie music festivals.

4.4 Policies improved in the regions

Smaland (Kalmar and Kronoberg)/Blekinge



- It is of great importance not only to include civil servants in the activities, but also decision makers. In order to take action and make improvements both civil servants and decision makers need to gain understanding, information and knowledge.
- The municipality of Oskarshamn has a very good cooperation with the University of Linköping and the institution of Energy Systems. They have great knowledge and experience of energy efficiency in housing. The cooperation between the municipality of Oskarshamn and the University of Linköping gives us the academic knowledge and the municipal competence, needs and prerequisites.

5.1. Long term impacts & future prospects

- Interregional approach in the development and improvement of training tools and methods in energy efficiency for authorities and employees of public institutions in the project is implemented in EEMTE by:
- The cooperation of the partners from four different European regions diversified in terms of progress towards the EU objectives in energy efficiency and climate protection
- Exchange of experiences, identification of good practices and transfer of knowledge between project participants and the promotion of project results among other relevant government bodies in the regions
- Building and consolidating a new partnership through cooperation of political entities, decision-makers, public administration staff, training institutions and citizens involved in the project
- Joint development of valuable and universal training tools, which will be in future developed and refined

5.2. Long term impacts & future prospects

- Project results will be disseminated and made available to the authorities and other bodies responsible for implementing regional and local policies on energy efficiency. For this purpose, a manual will be jointly developed and released, as a result of the EEMTE project
- Political bodies of the project partners will take political initiatives (Council resolution, instruction) to enable effective implementation of the project results at local, regional and supra-regional levels.
- Trough partnerships established via EEMTE in the regions and developed training material that will be made available also to other stakeholders in the region the outcomes of EEMTE will be used also after the end of the EnercitEE Mini-Program. Furthermore EEMTE Partners will set up some kind of overview on existing concepts, different methods and regional approaches (finally brochure) as a the evaluation report who will be available in English and widely disseminated.
