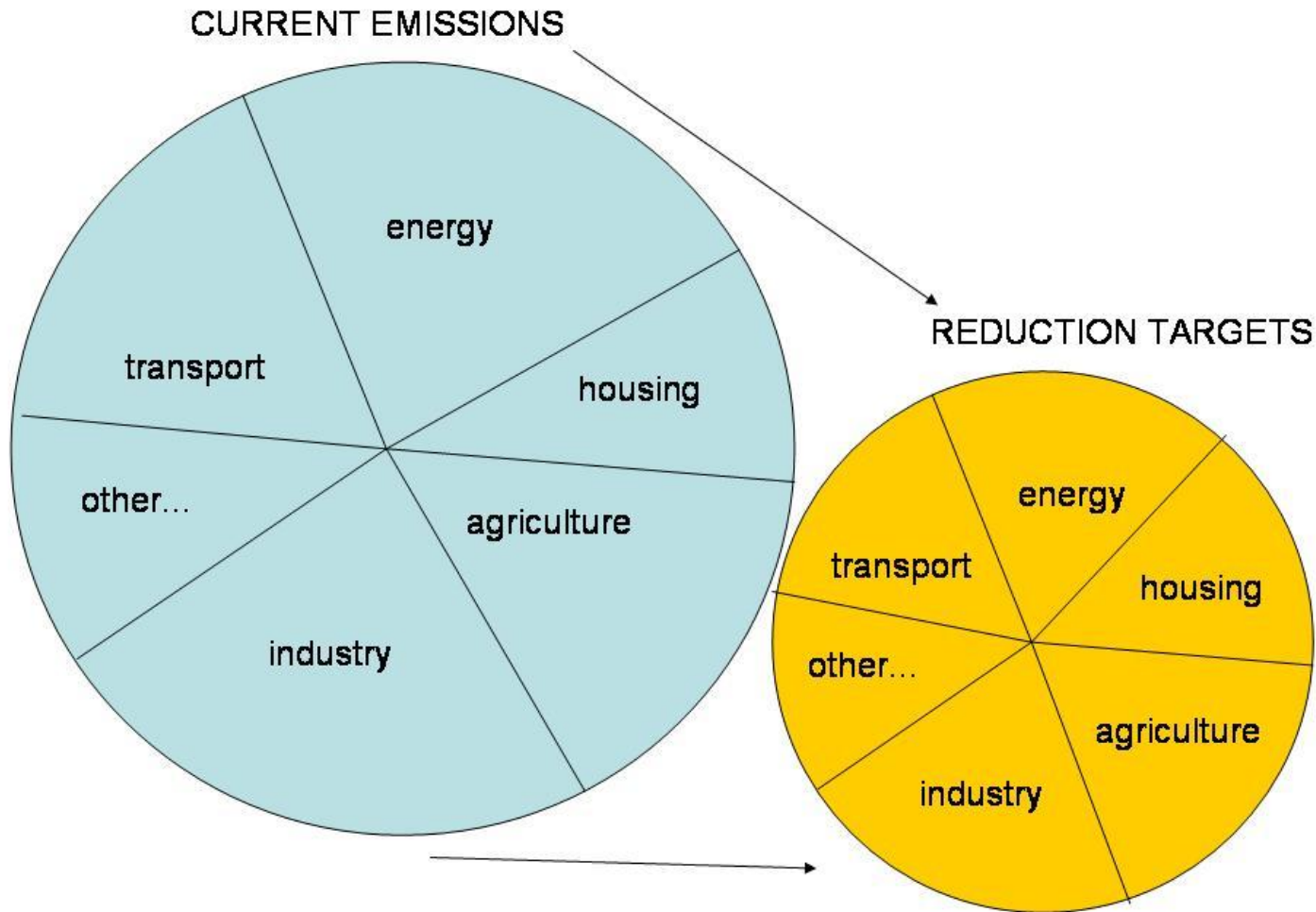

- Guidelines and examples for adaptation planning

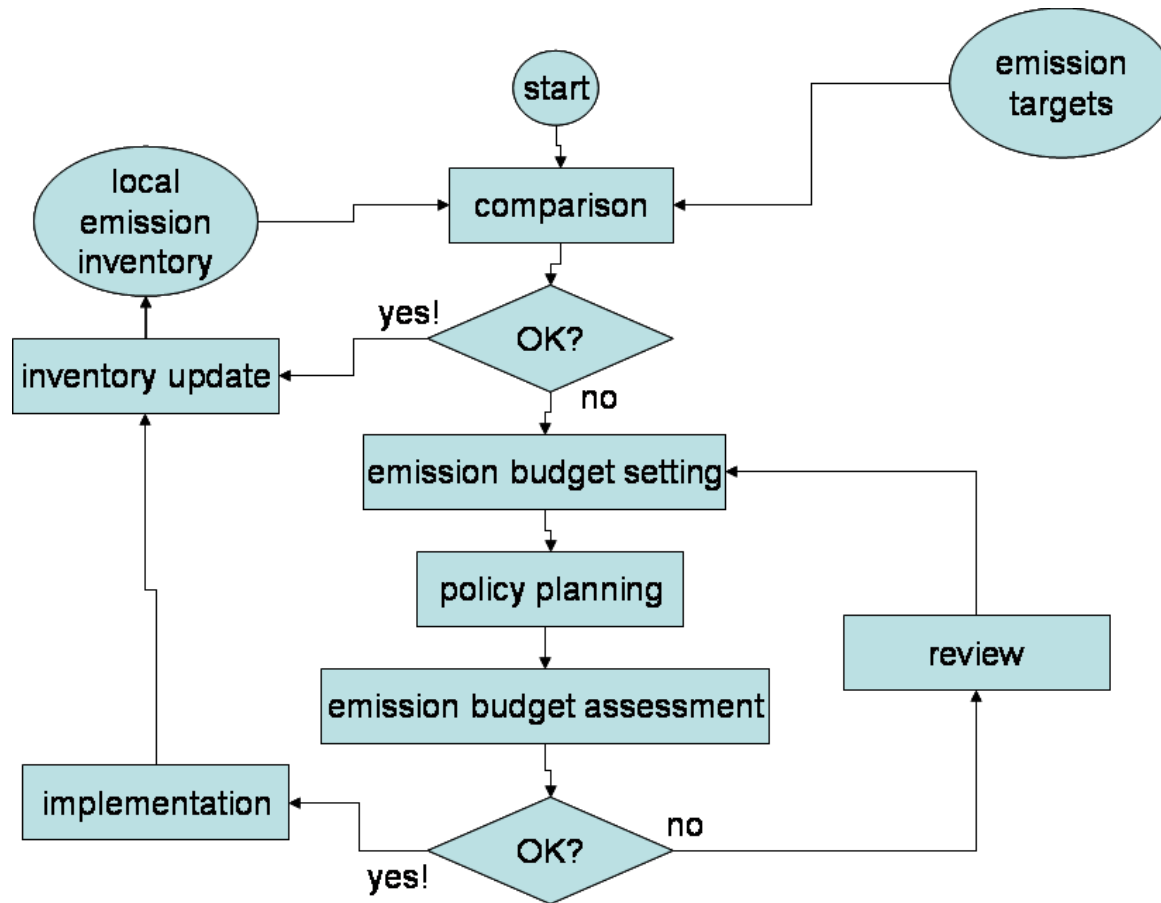
Example: Setting overall and sectoral **emission targets** is essential to ensure the actual implementation of ghg emission reduction policies at the regional and local level. Targets should be determined starting from current emissions computed from sufficiently detailed **emission inventories**.

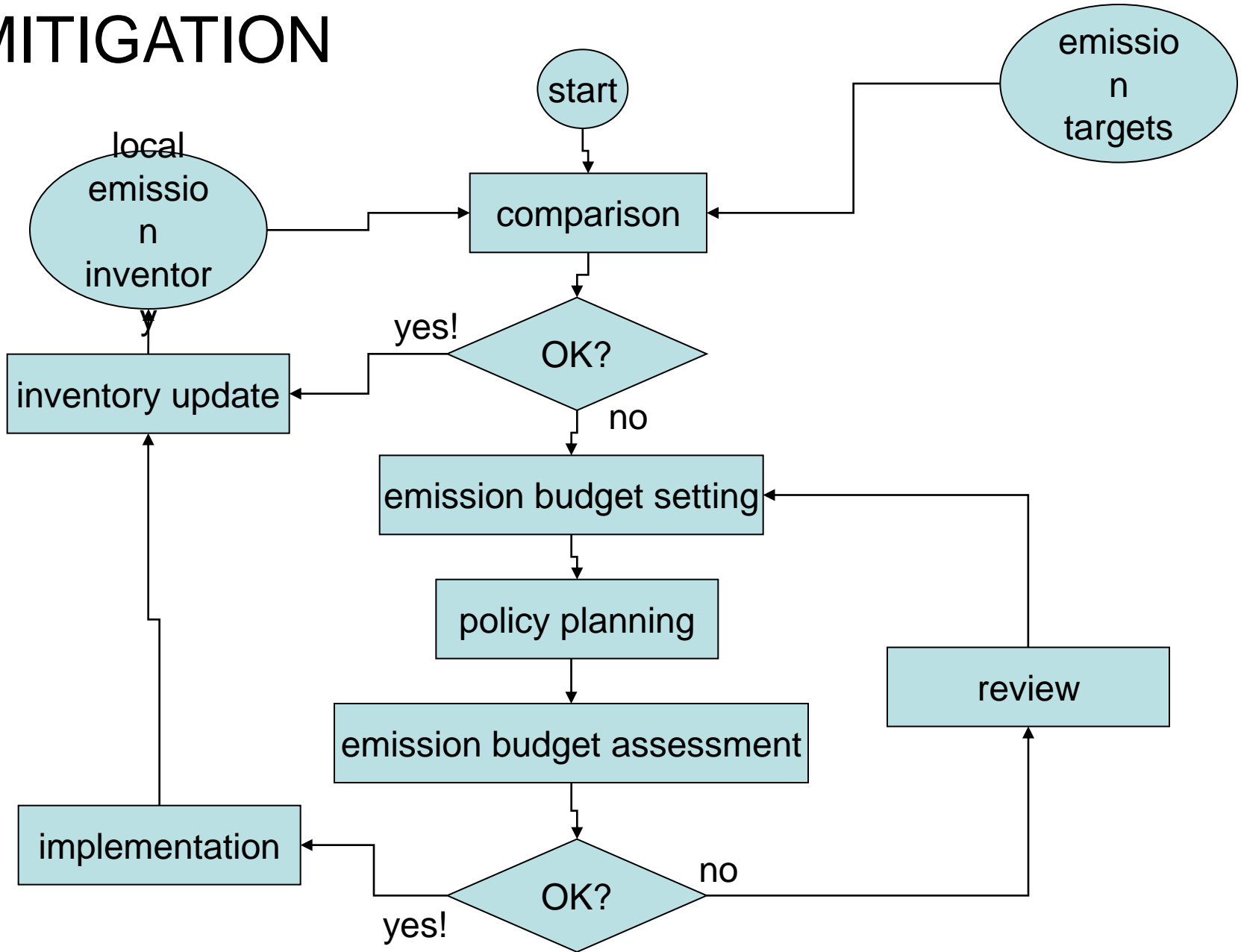


A cycle of budget setting, policy planning and review that could ensure convergence of regional and local emissions towards previously set emission targets. Clipart subproject will provide regional and local authorities with the needed tools to set annual or periodical emission budgets and to evaluate and check policies against emission budgets. Subsequent inventory update ensures a further general check after implementation.

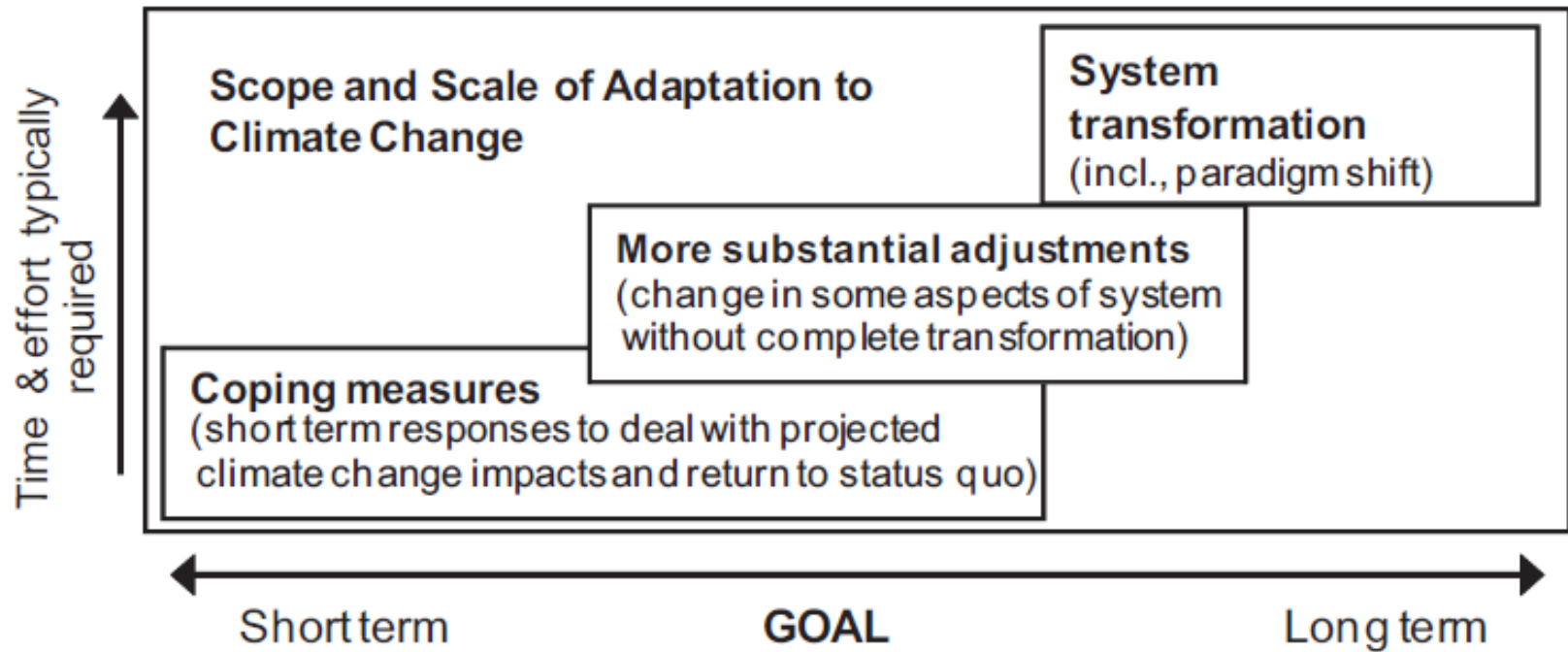
